## **NOTICE**

Following are the new dates for B.A.LL.B. (Honours in Adjudication and Justicing) Admission process i.e., Psychometric Test, Group Discussion, and Personal Interview:

- 1. Psychometric Test November 26, 2020 (i.e., Thursday);
- 2. Group Discussion November 27, 2020 (i.e., Friday); and
- 3. Personal Interview November 28 & 29, 2020 (i.e., Saturday & Sunday)

## **Instructions for Psychometric Test:**

- i. Psychometric Test will be conducted as Online proctored exam.
- ii. To appear for the Psychometric Test candidates are required to have below listed Browsers / Versions only with Web Camera / Front Camera:
  - ➤ Google Chrome (Version 60 and above);
  - ➤ Mozilla Firefox (Version 60 and above);
  - ➤ Mobile Google Chrome Browser on Android Phone (if taking the Test through mobile phone);
- iii. Before starting the Psychometric Test, please ensure that you have disabled all the Popup / Notifications;
- iv. Maximum time allotted for the proctored Online Psychometric Test is Thirty (30)
  Minutes:
- v. The URL, Username and Password to login will be shared with the candidates via registered e-mail id on **November 25, 2020** by **6:00 p.m.** from **'donot-reply@amcatmail.com'** only'
- vi. The candidates are required to complete the Psychometric Test on the next day i.e., **November 26, 2020** from **10:00 a.m.** to **1:00 p.m.** After 1:00 p.m. the Portal will closed:
- vii. The Username and Password can be used only for one attempt. Therefore, the candidates are required to do the Psychometric Test carefully;
- viii. The Candidate are not allowed to skip any question in the Psychometric Test;
- ix. After successful completion of the Psychometric Test candidates will receive an acknowledgement e-mail.
- x. After login, to start the Psychometric Test candidate should show valid Photo Identity Card in front of the Web Camera.

## **Instructions for Group Discussion:**

- i. The Group Discussion will be conducted as Online proctored via Zoom Online Platform;
- ii. The candidates are required to download the Zoom Application on the device for Group Discussion;
- iii. Candidates will be sent a Zoom Meeting link on November 26, 2020;
- iv. The candidate should login Ten (10) Minutes before their time slot and wait in the waiting room;
- v. Candidate will be admitted by the coordinator Five (5) Minutes before the Group Discussion session;

- vi. After the allotted starting time of Group Discussion session, the Meeting Room will be closed, late comers will not be allowed to enter and they will be marked as absent;
- vii. The entire Group Discussion sessions will be recorded;
- viii. The Candidates should login in Zoom with their Student Id and name, candidate logging in with the names of their devices (eg. iphone 12, Samsung) will be rejected/removed;
  - ix. The Candidate should be in a room free of distractions and noise;
  - x. The Candidate will need a webcam and microphone on their laptop/computer so the online coordinator can see and hear them during the Group Discussion sessions;
- xi. The Candidate should make sure that there is proper lighting on them and test their microphones in advance;
- xii. The Candidate should set the camera in landscape mode with their image properly centred:
- xiii. The Candidate should make sure that their desk or table top is empty and free of any papers, books, post-it notes, or writing instruments such as pens, markers, whiteboards, or pencils etc;
- xiv. The Candidate will be allowed to keep a water bottle and clear Photo Identity card;
- xv. The Candidate should ensure nobody comes in the room while they are taking the Group Discussion session; if this occurs, their Group Discussion will be terminated;
- xvi. The Candidate should sit in the same place for the entire duration of the Group Discussion session;
- xvii. The Candidate has no option to take breaks; if he/she takes a break, then his/her Group Discussion session will be terminated;
- xviii. The Candidate with their webcam, phone or laptop may be asked to pan their full room, failing which they may not be permitted to take the Group Discussion session;
  - xix. Additional monitors must be unplugged and turned away;
  - xx. Additional computers must be turned off and monitors must be dark;
  - xxi. If the Candidate is found using any unfair means during the Group Discussion session will be disqualified.

**Note:** Separate instructions for Personal Interview will be sent to the candidates those who are shortlisted for Personal Interview
