ANNUAL REPORT OF MAHARASHTRA NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY, NAGPUR FROM APRIL 01, 2019 TO MARCH 31, 2020

1. INTRODUCTION

The Annual Report was prepared by the Executive Council regarding working of the University in pursuance of the requirement as per Section 37 of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014 for presentation before the General Council of the University for its consideration and approval as required by Section 14(3) of the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014. The period covered in this report is the financial year from April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020. The University commenced its academic session for odd Semesters on June 17, 2019 for the semesters III, V, VII of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) Five-Year Integrated Degree Course and classes for the new batch i.e., Semester-I of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Courses commenced on July 15, 2019. End Semester Examinations concluded between November 25-30, 2019, and result was declared on December 11, 2019. The subsequent Semesters commenced on January 02, 2020. During (winter) semester breaks, students went for the internships.

The University received the BCI Final letter vide letter no. BCI;D;272/2020(LE-F/std.22/23/.22/23/24.6.2018) dated March 03, 2020 after confirmation/ratification by the Legal Education Committee and General Council of the Bar Council of India with regard to earlier letter, *vide* letter no. BCI;D;882/2018(LE/std. 22/23/24.6.2018) dated July 10, 2018 relating to recognition and Fresh Approval to MNLU, Nagpur to impart Five-Year Integrated Degree Course, B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) with intake of two session of 60 students in each section for a period of two years i.e., for the academic years 2018-19 and 2019-20.

4.6 Common Law Admission Test (CLAT)-2019

The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT)-2019 was conducted on May 26, 2019 at Eighty-Four (84) Centres including Nagpur, wherein 56,247 Candidates appeared for Undergraduate Degree Course (out of which 28,249 were Male and 27,998 were Female). Further, 757 were allotted to Nagpur Centre wherein 710 appeared for the Examination.

For Postgraduate Degree Course 6,587 candidates appeared for CLAT -2019 (out of which 2,931 were Male and 3,655 were Female). Further, 141 were allotted to Nagpur Centre wherein 131 appeared for the Examination. 11 candidates took admission to the LL.M. (One-Year Postgraduate) Degree Course Batch 2019-20 at the University.

6. CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT / INFRASTRUCTURE

6.1 Present Campus

The present campus is 39,837 sq.ft. carpet area on rent i.e., MORAJ Design and Decorators (DnD) Building, near Mihan Flyover Wardha Road, Khapri-Nagpur. The University being residential, hostel facility is provided to the students in MORAJ Waterfall Gateway Township, Mihan, Nagpur.

6.2 Permanent Campus

As per the resolution of the Building Committee in its meeting held on October 19, 2019, the implementing agency of the Project, i.e., Public Works Department, Nagpur Circle, Government of Maharashtra floated the Tender as third recall. Against this third recall following four (04) bidders participated in the process:

1. Dee Vee Projects Limited;
2. Yashnand Engineers and Contractors Pvt. Ltd.;
3. Nyati Engineers and Consultants JV; and
4. Super Construction Company Joint Venture.

Further, as resolved in the Building Committee Meeting held on November 1, 2019 a Committee consisting of:

- (i) Shri Basawraj Pandhare, S.E. Vigilance, Chairman;
- (ii) Shri Raobahadur Patil, Member;
- (iii) Shri Yogesh Kulkarni, Member; and
- (iv) Shri Prashant Shankarpure, Representative of the Public Works Department, Nagpur.

visited the works of the above Four (04) Bidders and submitted a detailed report to the Chief Engineer, Public Works Region, Nagpur. Furthermore, the Officials of the Public Works Department, Nagpur informed that aforementioned bidders qualified in the Technical Bid and their Financial Bid were opened on December 6, 2019 and their Bids are as follows:

1. Rs.211,84,92,851.16/- (Dee Vee Projects Limited);
2. Rs.225,81,62,172.09/- (Yashnand Engineers and Contractors Pvt. Ltd.);
3. Rs.252,31,52,674.90/- (Nyati Engineers and Consultants JV); and
4. Rs.211,70,03,169.54/- (Super Construction Company Joint Venture).

The Bid of Super Construction Company Joint Venture was the lowest. The Bid was approved by Competent Authority from Mantralaya on December 13, 2019. The Building Committee took note of the Grants approved and received from the Government of Maharashtra. The Government of Maharashtra has given an administrative sanction for 231 Crores (Two Hundred and Thirty-One Crores Only) out of which 150 Crores (One Hundred and Fifty Crores Only) have been sanctioned by the Government of Maharashtra. Out of 150 Crores the University has received an amount of Rs.87,76,40,582/- (Eighty-Seven Crores Seventy-Six Lakhs Forty Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-Two Only) out of which an amount of Rs.87,59,23,085/- (Eighty-Seven Crores Fifty-Nine Lakhs Twenty-Three Thousand and Eighty-Five Only) was spent by the University (Annexure-IV). The Grants to be received from Government of Maharashtra is Rs.62,23,59,418/- (Sixty-Two Crores Twenty-Three Lakhs Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Eighteen Only). A letter was issued to Government of Maharashtra through the Higher and Technical Education to release the remaining (Rs.62,23,59,418/- (Sixty-Two Crores Twenty-Three Lakhs Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Eighteen Only), the Government of Maharashtra duly asked for Utilization Certificate of the Grants received till date towards the Construction of Permanent Campus of the University at Waranga. The University

sent the Utilization Certificate on January 9, 2020 with a request to release the funds as early as possible towards construction of Phase-I Civil Construction.

Approach Road to the Permanent Campus of the University

All the necessary permissions were obtained from the Competent Authority except NOC from Higher and Technical Education Department (for parting 12 Meters of land to Nagpur Metropolitan Region Development Authority, Nagpur). Mr. Nitin Kshirsagar, Desk Officer, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya who attended the Meeting of the Building Committee held on December 14, 2019 informed that necessary papers have been received and NOC will be processed. After receiving the NOC the same will be handed over to the District Collector who in turn will hand over the land, i.e., 24 Meters stretch for developing DP Road to the Nagpur Metropolitan Region Development Authority, Nagpur / Public Works Department, Nagpur for development of DP Road. It was also resolved that a Motorable Road will be developed to be used during the Construction period. As on the date, there is no Approach Road to the Permanent Campus of the University at Waranga.

Building Plan Sanction

The University has received necessary approval from Nagpur Metropolitan Region Development Authority, Nagpur towards sanction of Building Plans on December 31, 2019. Further, the University has applied to Fire Officer Nagpur on January 4, 2020 for obtaining necessary sanction.

Bulk Water Entitlement of 0.1094 Cubic Meter from Wakeshwar Dam

The Building Committee was informed that the University has applied for necessary sanctions to the Water Resource Department, Nagpur for reservation of Water from Wakeshwar Dam to the Permanent Campus of the University at Waranga. The Water Resource Department, Nagpur has forwarded the same to the Water Resource Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai and the same has been duly approved by the Competent Authorities of Water Resource Department. On December 4, 2019 the University has received a communication from Deputy Executive Engineer, Water Resource Department, Nagpur asking the University to pay a Demand of Rs.13,72,000/- (Thirteen Lakhs Seventy-Two Thousand Only) towards the restoration charges of the Irrigation affected area of 13.72 Hectors. The Building Committee resolved that payment as required shall be transferred. The University transferred the above mentioned amount on January 3, 2020.

7.3 Diploma Programme

The University offers Postgraduate Diploma in ‘Alternative Dispute Resolution’; Postgraduate Diploma in ‘Family Dispute Resolution’; and Postgraduate Diploma in ‘Energy Laws and Policy’. 7.4 Ph.D. Degree Programme

7.4.1 Admission to Ph.D. Degree Programme-2019

The University notified the admission for Ph.D. Degree Programme-2019 on September 24, 2019. The last date for receipt of Filled-in Application was October 24, 2019. 61 applications were received by the university before the last date. Twenty-seven candidates were exempted from appearing in All India Entrance Test (AIET)-2019 (being qualified UGC NET, JRF, CSIR, SLET, GATE, M.Phil., or already obtained Ph.D. Degree in any disciplines), and 34 candidates (Law-31; Company Secretary-1; Tourism & Travel Management-1; Development Studies-1) were found eligible to appear in All India Entrance Test (AIET)-2019.

The All India Entrance Test (AIET)-2019 was conducted on November 10, 2019 at Nagpur Centre, wherein 31 candidates (Law-28; Company Secretary-1; Tourism & Travel Management-1; Development Studies-1) appeared in the examination. From the pool of candidates from exempted and qualified in AIET, a merit list of 15 candidates and waiting list of 10 candidates was notified by the university on January 27, 2020. The candidates in merit list were required to report to the University on February 14, 2020 to complete the admission process. Dr. Himanshu Pandey, Associate Professor of Law, was nominated as the Coordinator of the Ph.D. Course Work 2019 to oversee the smooth conduct of the Ph.D. Course Work in accordance with the directions of the Research Committee.
